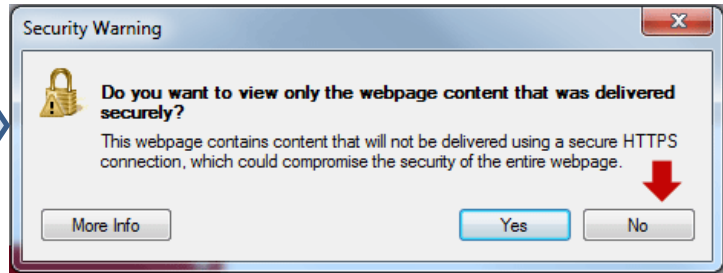


How to disabling the “Security Warning” pop-up message.

To continue, you would click the “No” button.

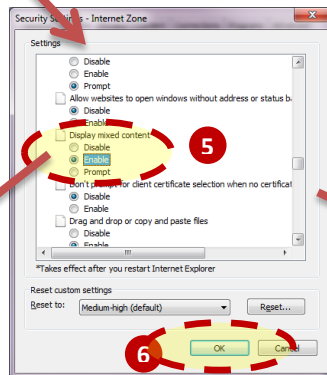
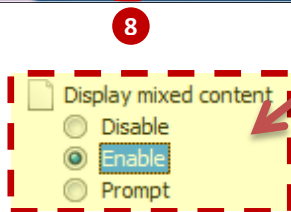
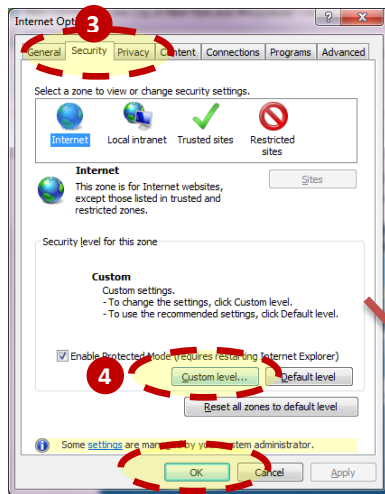
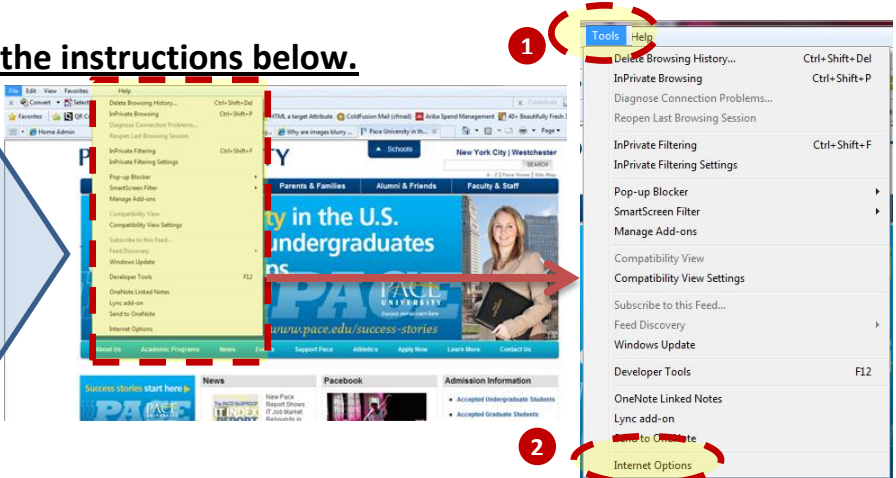


You will get this warning when you are on a secured website (https protocol) page and the page you are navigating to is attempting to load non secure content. This is due to the version you may have installed on your computer.

To “Disable” this message follow the instructions below.

Open the Internet Explore

1. Click on “Tool” on the top menu.
2. Scroll down and select “Internet Options”.



3. Click on the “Security” tab.
4. Click on the “Custom level” button.
5. Scroll down to “Display mixed content” option and select “Enable” then click on the “OK” button.
6. Click the “OK” button
7. Click “Yes” to change the setting for this zone.
8. Click “OK” button to complete the process.
